Grammar Topic/Focus/Essential Question

Passe Compose and Imparfait Compared

How to write a lesson plan

Objective(s) (What we want our students to know, understand, be able to do) Be specific!!

*Students will be able to identify the differences between the two forms of the past tense and begin to use them appropriately in context.

*Students will understand how to create a lesson plan for the “Revisions” project

Assessment (How I will know they know?)

A Faire: identify what expressing in each sentence, make revisions, add in expressions of time to demonstrate understanding

Instructional Activities (Include time needed and who will do it)

1. Warm-up: Students use prepared homework (contrasting PC/IMP) in oral activity
 - point out that question is habitual action vs. answer is one time exception -pg 321 #9 (10min)
 - questions pour Florence
2. Go over PC/IMP compared handout. Note specific action/time vs. continuous/habitual/description/state of mind. Also: repeated specific # of times=PC
 - English comparison: were...-ing, used to, would (sense of used to)
 - Expressions: time and adverbs (note placement)
 - Imparfait describes action going on in the past when something happened
 - common state of mind verbs in past (imp) (20 min)

3. A Faire: use previous free write... identify what expressing in each sentence
-SP-specific point, SA-specific action, C-continuous action, H-habitual, D-description, SOM-state of mind.
-Make corrections to verbs if necessary
-Incorporate at least 4 expressions into the writing (handout/book) *stamp
HW (15min)
4. Introduce lesson plan overview and specific lesson plan (10min)
-Write details, step by step, with times and who is doing what
-Address any student questions about plan
5. Work time/Planning time for review lessons (20min)
6. Closing/Homework/Deadlines (5min)
