



Materials:

- Worsted weight yarn - 2 + colors
- US size 9 knitting needles
- Yarn needle
- Polyfill

Notes:

Knitted dammit doll...approx 16" tall.

If you want a larger doll increase your needle and yarn size, for a smaller one use smaller needles and yarn. Just make sure you use a needle that will give you a tight weave.

Use yarn held double throughout project.

Use any color of worsted weight yarn...go crazy and mix different colored skeins and a contrasting color for the eyes and mouth.

Directions:

Right leg (front):

Cast on 9 stitches

Stockinette stitch x 30 rows (begin with knit row, end with purl row)
Cut yarn

Left leg (front):

Using the same needle right leg is on, cast on 9 stitches
Stockinette stitch x 30 rows (beg with knit row, end with purl row)

Join legs (front):

Knit across both left and right leg
Purl row

Body(front):

SSK, knit to last 2 stitches, k2tog
SSP, purl to last 2 stitches, p2tog
Stockinette stitch x20 rows (begin with knit row, end with purl row)

Arms (front):

Cast on 15 stitches beginning of row, knit row
Cast on 15 stitches beginning of row, purl row
Stockinette stitch x 4 rows (begin with knit row, end with purl row)
Bind off 16 stitches beginning of row, knit row
Bind off 16 stitches beginning of row, purl row

Head (front to back):

SSK, knit to last 2 stitches, k2tog
Stockinette stitch x 29 rows (begin & end with purl row)
KFB, knit to last stitch, KFB

Arms (back):

Cast on 16 stitches beginning of row, purl row
Cast on 16 stitches beginning of row, knit row
Stockinette stitch x 4 rows (begin with purl row, end with knit row)
Bind off 15 rows beginning of row, purl row
Bind off 15 rows beginning of row, knit row

Body (back):

Stockinette stitch x 20 rows (begin with purl row, end with knit row)
PFB, purl to last stitch, PFB
KFB, knit to last stitch, KFB

Separate for legs (back):

Purl row
Knit row

Left leg (back):

Stockinette stitch first 9 stitches x 30 rows
(begin with purl, end with knit row)
Bind off 9 stitches
Cut yarn

Right leg (back):

Rejoin yarn to remaining 9 stitches with purl row
Stockinette stitch x 29 rows (begin with knit row, end with knit row)
Bind off 9 stitches

Finishing:

Fold body in half matching up fronts and backs of arms and legs as you sew up body, stuffing as you go. Tie in yarn for hair and use contrasting yarn to sew on face.
