At the July 11th skills clinic, everyone was going around saying their name and pronouns. When it got to Mark Henry, he said, "He/him, I guess. I'm old, we didn't really do this sort of thing." Many people at the skills clinic heard it and it made multiple people uncomfortable.

Hey, Mark. I want to address the way you introduced yourself this evening at the clinic. After we all went around and said our name and pronouns, you introduced yourself with, "Mark Henry. He...he I guess. I don't know. I'm old. We didn't do all this."

I know that you have been in this league long enough, and have attended enough events, that you are familiar with introductions using the Name and Pronoun format. I also know that you know your own pronouns. The only reasons I can think of to say what you said would be to let everyone know that you are uncomfortable or in disagreement with the inclusive practice of offering pronouns so that trans folks don't have to experience as much misgendering at NFFLA events. As a trans person who has been misgendered often over the last three years in this league, including by you, this attitude is really painful, and angering. You were there in a leadership capacity tonight, representing the league as an expert. Your commentary after your introduction plays into common, painful messages trans people receive throughout society that our presence and our identity are confusing, burdensome, and/or an inconvenience to others. I responded with "it's not that hard" in the moment that you said what you said, but I need you to know that your comment ruined my experience this evening.

Typically, I would pull someone aside and speak to them directly if I were upset by something they said or did. However, I believe that you know too much for your comment tonight to have been simply reckless. I believe that you were intentionally communicating to the group that you find the practice of offering pronouns inconvenient and uncomfortable. As such, I am copying Emily because I believe accountability is needed. If you were trying to communicate something else and I have misinterpreted, I would be grateful to hear from you what that was.
