Info

- -The RLBot HoopShot 2018 Tournament will be hosted **November 17th & 18th** beginning at **5pm UTC (12pm EST)** each day.
- Dropshot (2v2) November 17th
- Hoops (3v3) November 18th

Bot submissions are due Wednesday November 14tth, 4am UTC (11pm EST)
The bot submissions deadline is over.

RLBot is a software library that allows custom bots to play Rocket League in offline play. The RLBot HoopShot 2018 Tournament will determine which fan-made bots are best in their respective brackets.

Rules

- 1. Submitted bots should run on RLBot v4
- 2. The only live data bots may use is that from the gameTickPacket
- 3. Bots should not contain (and will be checked for) malicious code
- 4. The host has the final jurisdiction and is responsible for ensuring smooth flow through the tournament by any means necessary
- 5. Fun is encouraged

Dropshot Bracket

Info:

The Dropshot bracket will be one of the two main modes this tournament. You can create your own pre-selected teams. If you are by yourself, you can create 3 different bots or 3 of the same bot to be on a team.

Details:

Depending on number of entries, this will either be a double elimination or a single elimination bracket.

All people of a team must agree to be on a team. There won't be any random pairing.

Your bots must be better than a team of Pro bots built by Psyonix at Dropshot. Seeding will be done by goals for - goals against in a game against the Pro bot.

This bracket will be run at 60 frames a second.

Hoops Bracket

Info:

The Hoops bracket will be one of the two main modes this tournament. You can create your own pre-selected teams. If you are by yourself, you can create 2 different bots or 2 of the same bot to be on a team.

Details:

Depending on number of entries, this will either be a double elimination or a single elimination bracket.

All people of a team must agree to be on a team. There won't be any random pairing.

Your bots must be better than a team of Pro bots built by Psyonix at Hoops. Seeding will be done by goals for - goals against in a game against the Pro bot.

This bracket will be run at 60 frames a second.
