Psychology Course Project

My Top 10 Takeaways from Psychology

Objective:

Reflect on the most impactful concepts, theories, or research findings from this course. Create a list of your "Top 10 Takeaways," explain their significance, and connect them to your life experiences through written and video formats.¹

Instructions:

Identify Your Top 10 Takeaways:

- Revisit the topics we've covered this semester. These can include theories, concepts, or significant research findings.
- Arrange them in descending order, with the most impactful concept as number 1, followed by the second most impactful, and so on.
- Add your top 10 list into a slidedeck presentation (create your own or make a copy of this template: Psychology Top 10 (Make a copy to edit). Add a brief description or add examples and some visuals (at least 5) to the slidedeck.
 - If it's not obvious in the slide, for each takeaway, write a brief explanation (around 100-150 words) to clarify what the concept is.
 - Explain why each concept is significant to you, or why it resonated with you the most.

Create a Video:

■ Record a video, between 3-5 minutes, where you discuss how these Top 10 Takeaways relate to your own life, aspirations, or experiences. You do not have to address all of the takeaways in your video, but must mention at least 3 of them. You can use the slide deck in your video or choose to go another route altogether.

■ Make sure to articulate the connections between different concepts and your personal experiences, so it's evident why these concepts made your list.

Evaluation Criteria:

- Depth of understanding demonstrated for each takeaway
- The relevance of each concept to your own life or broader societal issues
- Quality and coherence of your video presentation

Submission:

- Submit your ranked list and written explanations as Google slides, a ppt, or something similar.
- Upload your video. Ensure that the video and audio quality are clear.
