- ☐ An original piece of student media
- ☐ Length of piece is 2-5 minutes long
- ☐ Audio media is submitted via Soundcloud or Google Drive link with open permissions
- ☐ Must be free of hate speech. Hate speech is anything that degrades an entire group of people based on race, religion, nationality, gender, sexual orientation/identity or disability.
- ☐ Must not include any sound or music that is copyrighted by someone else.

	<p>Describes the topic and addresses the producer's role and interest in the story</p> <p>Has a clearly focused story arc with a beginning, middle, and end</p>	
	<p>Engages the audience by taking listeners on a journey through storytelling, action and sound</p> <p>Uses music to appropriately set the tone of the story</p>	
	<p>Includes transitions that are smooth and use sound and music intentionally to move through the story arc</p> <p>Has narration that is rehearsed with smooth delivery and enunciation, expression, pacing are effective</p>	
	<p>Examines the issue at depth, citing accurate and relevant evidence and sources</p> <p>If relevant, includes interview voices with clips or quotes that are accurately attributed to the speaker</p>	
	<p>Has an overall sound quality that is clear without unnecessary background noise</p> <p>Has a volume of narration that is consistent and balanced with other background sounds or music</p>
