An Email Message From The Campaign of Big Momma for Senate

This week, former Foreign Affairs Committee Ranking Member, Big Momma, made a trip to the United Arab Emirates where he met with leaders from across the Middle East to better educate himself on the current geopolitical situation in their region. After speaking with these leaders, Big Momma assued them that if he were elected to serve in Washington again that America's allies would continue to have a voice in defense of upholding their friendships and agreements. It's worth noting that Big Momma is the only candidate in this race that can make that promise to uphold America's reputation abroad, and that Olivia went to Israel once.

At a meeting of military families in Richmond, Big Momma discusses his trip.

"There is an abundance of importance to maintaining our obligations abroad. All we have as a country is our reputation, and if we sully that reputation by failing to uphold our obligations to our allies, then we will fall as we stand: defiant and alone." he says.

"But what about bringing our babies home, Mr. Momma, we'd been in places like

Afghanistan for years before President Gunnz came into power, are you against that?" a

mother inquires.

"I absolutely do support that, I believe that we have had a tendency of spending a lot of money to spread ourselves thin militarily. When we sit around twiddling our thumbs in Afghanistan with no goal but to build schools and sit around and wait until the Taliban burns them down so we can build them again, that's a waste of time and taxpayer dollars. We need to go in with a plan and we need to execute that plan and when the plan is executed we need to leave. But we also have prior obligations. Take our allies in Southeastern Asia for example. China and North Korea are very dangerous adversaries to just leave our friends alone. We need to maintain a presence in these areas to demonstrate to the Chinese or North Koreans or anyone else for that matter that if you attack them you attack us. They would do the same for us. If some sort of unprovoked attack happened on the US, South Koreans and Japanese would rush to our defense. We have to keep in mind that this is because we're reputable. So yes ma'am, I do

support the President's efforts, but with caution, and an abundance of it." Big Momma replies.

Another mother raises her hand, "But aren't we wasting money overseas, that's what other candidates in the race have told us, and we've tended to agree with them."

"It seems as though it does when you sit down and you analyze the balance sheet. You say 'oh good Lord, millions of billions of dollars in X place over Y amount of time, how horrific,' right? But you consider that we pull out of these places, take our escapade in Syria for example. Kurds were put at risk by Turks in Northern Syria, but the administration concluded that it just wasn't worth the time and effort we were putting into it. But then what we feared would happen did, and we had to freeze our dollars that were being channeled into mobilization back home and we had to spend even more money in the long run combatting the Turks. That can happen plenty of places where we have our troops based, and I won't be at the steering wheel if we make that mistake again," Big Momma explains.
