## WHAT IS TITLE I?

Title I is a federally funded program. Schools in which children from low-income families make up at least 40 percent of enrollment are eligible to receive Title I funds to operate school-wide programs that serve all children in the school in order to raise the achievement of the lowest-achieving students.
