

RULES

- Absolutely no tracing or heavily referencing
- There are two codewords within the rules that you must include in your comment to prove you've read this!
- You must have art and animation examples on your channel
- Not really beginner friendly
- No watermarks, whether they're personal watermarks or program ones, I will be adding them in the finished product!
- The first codeword is what you're using for your part (also please check the blacklist before you apply!!)
- Blood/slight gore is allowed since this is a horror map, but please do not include very explicit gore or nsfw
- You need to have Discord, as there will be a Discord server to keep track of the parts
- The due date is anytime before Halloween, at the very latest being October 29th/30th
- Please do not join if you aren't sure if you are gonna finish your part by then, as I really wanna get this out by Halloween and will be a bit heavy with wip checks
- Though the due date is a bit solid, I will be very loose with wip checks, but you will need to provide some sort of update, whether it being a wip or just a verbal update!
- Please do not ghost me, I completely understand if anything comes up and you aren't able to give a wip, but verbal updates are appreciated if you aren't able to give a wip!!
- The second codeword is your favorite horror media and a pumpkin emoji, if you don't have one just the pumpkin emoji is alright!
- There is no set color palate, but please do not make your part overly bright/not matching the tone of the song
- Three parts are allowed per person, though I will be taking the intro and outro
- Even though this is a lot, please do not feel pressured!! I completely understand if you need more time or need to drop, just please do not right before the due date!

BLACKLIST

There isn't really a solid blacklist, it just needs to be some sort of horror media, whether it be a movie, book, game, or some sort of horror au from a non-horror media! The only thing I'd say is not allowed is overly nsfw media Also also please tell me if you're using an au or not, as I will be checking all of the media people apply with!
