Meeting Minute Approval	 Kendra Motioned for Approval of September's meeting minutes Jenn Seconded the mention Motion was passed and September 2019 meeting minutes will be posted on the website and shared in the Weekly Office Update
Family Fun Night	 A committee is needed to run Family Fun Night this year. If no committee is formed, Family Fun Night will not run this year. Committee would need to be established by December, consist of at least three people and work independently Kendra would have oversight of the Family Fun Night Committee Profit from last year's Family Fun Night was approximately \$4000-\$5000 Profits expected to be less for Family Fun Night 2020 (if it happens) due to less donations of food for the event Lack of volunteer participation is a problem in our school community For Family Fun Night to run smoothly, a minimum of 60 volunteers are needed Last year roughly 10% of volunteers for Family Fun Night did not show up for their shift Each year is a struggle to get enough volunteers to run the event There is a need to increase parent involvement in our school Further Options to Consider for Family Fun Night Reducing the scale and hosting a family picnic night instead Use the vendor to run the event and provide volunteers More risk involved with this option as we would increase our costs with the potential of not breaking even if participation is low
Hot Lunch	 Meaghan has been working on lunch option Looked at Swiss Chalet but they will not take our school due to the volume of potential orders needed in a short delivery window Potentially 400 chicken meals ordered from our school
	Kendra has been speaking with Bingemans about a potential hot lunch option

	 Potential to portion meals at the school to keep costs lower but would depend on volunteers Kendra to obtain pricing options This option would not be available until at least early 2020 due to the vendor's holiday season Milk Program Our school does not have the space for a milk program Concern about the smell if milk is forgotten by a child Popcorn Grade 4 will run popcorn it with volunteer oversight Cookies Cookies Cookie purchases will be added to school day for an added treat for students Cookies meet the food guidelines Vegan options available We would need to approach companies who can handle our volume (potentially 200-400 meals), meet the nutritional guidelines, can transport the food to our school and have a reasonable price point Volunteers would be needed to successfully run additional hot lunch programs
