

Official Local Harmony Funding Disclosure, Ethics & Guidelines for New Artists

All podcast costs are currently and ethically supported by Evan by means of gardening. The podcast is just a podcast, a hobby, and not a business. Promotion is free for artists of all walks of life and genre. Selection is based on taste, sincerity of art, respect for Local Harmony, and the artist's current location; the artist(s) must be based in Central Valley, California. The artist's last name will not be publicly shown to protect the privacy of the artist, but upon request of the artist, will be provided. There are these additional guidelines that are to be followed in order to be featured:

1. Must be your own work, or officially licensed music. No AI music. Artists grant Local Harmony to the usage of their music by agreeing to be on the podcast.
2. Must not contain hate speech.
3. Must not glorify crime, violence, or defame, threaten, or disrespect another human being. If the artist has done this in other songs in their catalog, or produces such work in the future, despite wanting to feature tracks on the podcast that don't contain such rhetoric, they will be removed from the podcast and may be blocked from the platform to ensure safety.
4. If any of previous concerns are found in the actions of said artist outside of their music, they will be denied a podcast, or having done a podcast, will have their podcast removed, and will be blocked.
5. Mutual respect is a must, and disrespect towards Evan, or any artists featured previously, or in the future for that matter, will result in blocking and removal from the podcast.

If any ethical concerns, guidelines, and basic boundaries are violated, an investigation will be conducted, upon confirmation, the artist's podcast will be deleted, artist may be blocked, and if any physical or emotional threats are made, either overtly or covertly, the artist will be blocked, and if actions escalate, the authorities will be contacted. To ensure safety, not just for Evan, but also the artists featured.

Local Harmony is meant for adults. It features explicit content unintended for anyone under 18. It is up to parental discretion to allow their child to listen to this podcast. It features explicit language, drinking, sometimes on the podcast, legal marijuana use, and sarcasm unsuitable for children. If any of this explicit content offends you, please, feel free to unfollow. Any activity intended to undermine the podcast, or support individuals who are doing this, will result in blocking.
