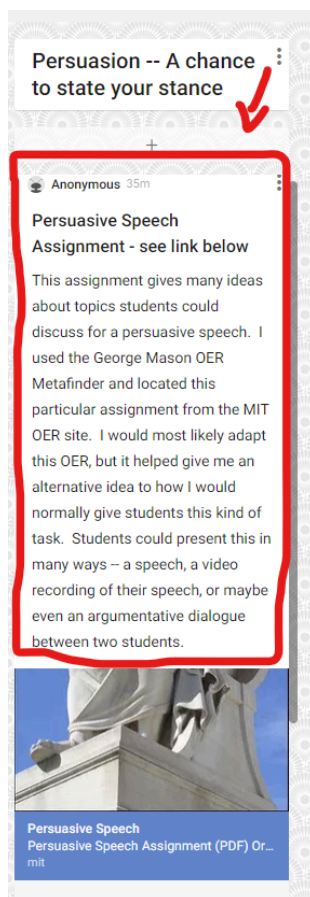
Summary Reflection

I found this exercise enlightening. It dawned on me when I was instructed to reevaluate the resources I chose that I did not thoroughly examine whether they stand up to the CRAAP test. In many ways, not all resources and content need to be scholarly peer reviewed, but it helped me gain perspective on my educational practice -- perhaps I need to be more thorough.

I also appreciated seeing how my CRAAP evaluation stood up against other's posts. I felt this was a valuable learning moment for me and I would consider implementing a similar activity in my own class. Seeing other people's comments helped me realize how not everyone views resources the same way, even if asked to review them through the same conceptual lens, i.e. the CRAAP test. Overall, this was a helpful exercise.
