MAYCO [STROKE AND COAT](#) - Super versatile, highly pigmented, and glossy without clear on top. No fail reds! I use these for my jewelry too. I purchase the smallest bottles to test (2oz. squeeze) and then will invest in larger or more. Note that a little goes a long way. Current favorites are candy apple red, hot tamale, pink-a-boo, orange ya happy, dandelion.
