 - America's Challenge Trail is composed of 2 sections. #1 #15 are park and grabs along a quiet Country Road. #16 #50 are on a hike / bike trail along the scenic Cheat Lake. The trail has a gate that locks every night, so daylight caching only ... and don't plan to get started *too* early. Parking is only available around cache number #15 and #20, otherwise, you'll enjoy about a 6 mile round trip hike. All the caches are fairly close to the trail, but that doesn't mean you won't be climbing a tree or two or doing a hill scramble.
 - For the puzzle lovers, make sure to solve GCA4ADZ, as it's on the trail as well!

Challenge Cache Moratorium?!!

A 1 year halt on all challenge cache publishing gave GCHQ time to rework the rules and guidelines for challenge caches. Post-moratorium challenge caches abide by different restrictions than pre-moratorium challenge caches, which have been 'grandfathered' as is.

Moratorium started: April, 2015 Moratorium ended: May 25, 2016
