App Powered by Pushpay

Personal information we collect

The personal information that we collect about you through the App depends on how you interact with us:

- *Information that you provide voluntarily*

We collect certain personal information from you when you choose to provide us with this information on or through our App, including but not limited to your first and last name, address, email address, and phone number.

- *Information that we collect automatically*

The App may collect certain information automatically from your device when you use it, such as information about the device or browser that you are accessing the App from or diagnostic data. In some countries, including countries in the European Economic Area ("EEA"), this information may be considered personal information under applicable data protection laws. The App may also collect information about how your device has interacted with the App, including the pages accessed and links clicked. How we use your personal information

- To record and track attendance at church services.

- To comply with legal obligations: We use your personal information as necessary when cooperating with law enforcement agencies, courts, and/or government authorities in accordance with our legal obligations under applicable laws.
- Third party service providers and vendors who provide services, including data processing services, for the Organization, for example, Pushpay.
- Others who otherwise process personal information for purposes that are described in this Privacy Policy.

Data security
