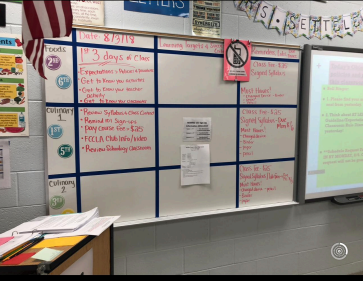



Welcome, Law & Public Safety Educators!

<p><b>NTI (New Teacher Institute)</b></p> <p><b>NTI POC:</b> Dr. Chris Smith,  <a href="mailto:Chris.Smith@education.ky.gov">Chris.Smith@education.ky.gov</a></p>	<p>Occupation-Based Teacher Certification:  <a href="https://louisville.edu/education/degreess/cte-teacher-certification">https://louisville.edu/education/degreess/cte-teacher-certification</a></p>	<p><b>What is the New Teacher Institute?</b> The New Teacher Institute is a 24-month induction model for all occupation-based Career and Technical Education (CTE) teachers pursuing professional teacher certification through the Kentucky Department of Education.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Teachers are required to complete the 24-month cycle that is a combination of face-to-face meetings, online meetings, and field-based support.</li> <li>Teacher candidates will complete the program as a cohort--candidates will start and finish the program together--which provides invaluable support and networking opportunities.</li> <li>During the first portion of the 24-month cycle, teacher candidates will participate in a mentoring component and receive support and direction from a veteran CTE teacher.</li> </ul> <p>The second portion of the 24-month cycle requires completion of the Kentucky Teacher Internship (KTIP) component.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>KTIP consists of classroom supervision, guidance and assessment from experienced classroom teachers.</li> <li>The teacher candidate is required to have an offer of employment from a Kentucky school district, the Kentucky Department of Education, or the Kentucky Community and Technical College System, at the start of the program.</li> </ul>

<p><b>KDE EOP (End of Program) Assessment Standards</b></p> <p>There are three sections of the exam – Academic, Employability and Occupational.</p>	<p><b>There is not currently an EOP option for Law &amp; Public Safety pathways. EOP Standards are developed as an <i>end of program assessment of four or more courses in a Career Pathway</i>. The EOP standards should be aligned within the <i>four courses</i> your school is offering for whatever Career Pathway is being offered.</p>	<p><b>FAQ's:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The cut score or pass rate of the EOP is 70%.</li> <li>• The exam consists of 120 questions.</li> <li>• 100 are point bearing and 20 are non-point bearing.</li> <li>• The 20 non-point bearing are pilot questions to obtain data to validate the questions. These pilot questions may be added to the test bank depending on the statistics obtained.</li> <li>• Twenty-five percent of the questions come from the Academic area, 25% of the questions come from the Employability area and 50% of the questions come from the Occupational area.</li> </ul>

The Kentucky Center for Education and Workforce Statistics (KCEWS) works with each local workforce investment board to give job and demand data for the region.</p> <p>Local workforce investment boards work with local economic development organizations and business to compile a list of industry-recognized certifications, licensures, and credentials, ranked by demand for that region.</p> <p>The lists are then given to the Kentucky Workforce Innovation Board (KWIB). Finally, the KWIB and KDE work together to edit and refine the list before KDE disseminates to all school districts. This work is done to ensure industry-recognized credentials are practical, relevant, and that they align with career pathways.</p>
