Customs

If you are shipping from outside the EU, you will need to follow Customs Regulations. Please note that in Italy, especially in Venice, the import/export of artworks is strongly controlled by the office of Fine Arts.

To allow the entrance of any kind of material in Italy, three kinds of import solutions could be available.

- Carnet A.T.A. (Temporary Admission): It allows temporary import/export in countries that
 adhere to the A.T.A. agreement with no need of any Customs fees. The temporary admission
 lasts a maximum of 12 months and it is specific for exhibitions and fairs. Changes of
 destination and changes in materials/contents are not permitted.
- Definitive import. It could be the easiest solution for all the materials which are not artworks and with a medium/low declared value. Italian Customs applies a 22% tax on the declared value plus an additional variable fee. For items declared as artworks Customs applies a 10% fee but longer procedures for the FineArt office are involved.
- Temporary import. It allows for temporary import/export in all countries. For these procedures a dedicated transportation company will have to deposit a bank guarantee on your behalf.

Please note that every Customs has special rules and cases, for this reason, we strongly suggest you to rely on a trustworthy transportation company to guide you and indicate to you the best solution.
