This post is basically a megathread on the user Oliri (https://osu.ppy.sh/users/12990538). He is an active player in the osu! community, particularly within taiko and standard. You may be aware of his notable TD #1 scores on high star jump maps. He is also a player with a known history of grooming minors, which have already been publicised. However, the reason this is being brought up again is because after his supposed "apology", he is still continuing to offend to the present day. I have been told I could wait up to 6 months for a response for my email reporting him, so in the meantime I would like to address the situation again to the public, in which he attempts to hide his presence, and to bring awareness for people that are not familiar with him. For people that already know the things that have happened in the past (up to 2024), skip ahead to the 2nd page onwards.

Oliri is known very well in the past to be a pedophile and groomer, spanning since 2022 as far as we're publicly aware. This was the main reddit post (January 2022)

To summarise, this was a 21 year old grooming a 15 year old. There is an extreme focus on him taking accountability, which is probably the only correct thing he has done, and then talks deeply about what he has done to improve himself and the plans for the future. It's honestly a convincing apology and comments in the reddit threads showcase this, people were willing to give him the chance to become a better human. Following this he performed a self restriction through multi accounting. His reasoning was due to attempting to hide his presence for fear of backlash. That apology however was rightfully deleted as it held zero validity. To start with, this is a twitlonger which was posted, it includes a personal statement which contains a multitude of experiences by an ex.



Summarised, he would have been 22 at this time, and was in a serious relationship with a 17 year old. He made the 17 year old lie about her age to others and showcased several forms of manipulation, particularly using self harm to manipulate people into staying into a relationship. It is very important to highlight the bottom of the post, where this is not a one off scenario, it has happened with multiple victims.

The next post is a bit more minimal, but it showcases how he continues this form of "mental breakdowns" likely to manipulate people to continue interacting with him. And once again, once contact has been cut he attempts to reconcile with them.

All of this was information that was visibly posted to the public and with digging anyone could access. We can see that for some once they are aware of who he is as a person, they are able to block and ignore any further contact, when he tries to do so. However, this is not always the case. The final situation I have to show is going to be the most compelling evidence which relates to him (now 24) grooming a 14, now 15 year old. This is a situation that I have been heavily involved in supporting the victim, so as such it's where I can talk the most to understand the severity of his actions. However her identity here will remain private in all talk at her request.

To start with, she was never aware of who Oliri was and his past, which I wouldn't necessarily expect him to talk about or bring up. Also to preface, going into this I did not have as much knowledge or understanding of his past, only just somehow remembering the first reddit post I linked. Knowing that he's talking to a minor was already setting off alarms, but I wasn't ready for how explicit this went.




The first image is after she brought up what I knew of him. Him not wanting to talk about his past is reasonable, but I was already questioning why he felt that "don't let others know about me" was required. And you can once again see this common theme of him attempting to hide things to the public. The girl was also already extremely vulnerable at the time so you can see

from her side she was extremely apologetic and did not want to cause trouble, which is something he's going to attempt to abuse.





It is likely true that he has trauma and has gone through therapy, this is what he has said in his apology. But from what I know now, he is particularly using this to guilt trip her to try to not share anything. I mean if there was nothing wrong, and he's looking to change for the better, then why don't other people need to know about him and what is there "more to happen". From here, I knew for certain something was seriously wrong.




For clarification, the particular longer lines of text that are censored is a nickname that he gave her. Most notably is the last two lines, he is attempting to not "let others push you", referring to likely sharing things that have happened in the past.


After this happened, he attempted to hide all his socials in discord, which I managed to have an image of beforehand.









It's becoming repetitive so going forward I'm going to not include these forms of manipulation and guilt trips. But it was growing extremely concerning that he would go to this level in order to hide whatever has happened between them. After a long period of encouraging and supporting her, she was willing to show some screenshots, and I'll just let you see for yourself.








And again, like with every case in the past, he ended up removing her from her friend list, but recently added her again and attempts to communicate again.

The moment I was aware of this situation with the victim that I personally know, I immediately began digging up the history, the past experiences and what I know now, in which I forwarded it all to the abuse email on osu!, which I expected to have a near immediate response time. After all its an email that is specifically targeted at this:

We have zero tolerance towards any sort of unwanted sexual attention or advances in this community.

However, when asked for an ETA on reading the emails, I was told this



To start with, I agree completely on the last 2 points. I have encouraged and supported her to go through this process, and she has been willing to report on discord at least. But taking it to the police will likely be a harder task, but not something I would give up on easily. For the second line, which is used to support his reasoning for the first line, I guess as someone who's been personally involved and as such more emotional to the situation, I just can't seem to accept. If it's the scenario of the email being clogged with things that do not relate to the abuse email at hand, I believe they should be easily discarded or redirected. And I believe the abuse email is already pretty clear in its definition so if anything they should quickly be told the importance of using this email to prevent further emails from clogging up. However, and what it has felt like he has suggested especially from the last line "i won't help you anyway" is that he wouldn't accept evidence that is clearly attributed to the abuser, if it's off another platform. From the way he has worded it, to me it seems pretty set in stone. But going off the official wiki:

On a public osu!—related Discord server

Immediately block the user by right-clicking their username and selecting Block in the drop-down list that appears.

Afterwards, contact the administrators of the server at once by looking for someone at the very top of the users list and let them know what happened. If you can't figure out who is an administrator, look for someone with a crown next to their name — they are the server owner and are responsible for what happens within it.

Should this abuse continue and the administrators do nothing about it, <u>please</u> notify the Discord Trust & Safety team by filing out a report.

In addition, if you know the osu! username of the person bothering you, please send an email to abuse@ppy.sh containing as much information as possible and it will be investigated promptly.

On a Twitter linked to an osu! user's profile

Click the three dots in the top right of the problem tweet and click 'Report Tweet'. Make sure to follow the prompts and read them carefully. You might also want to read Twitter's guide on reporting abusive behaviour for more information on the process.

Afterwards, either block or mute the user in question by clicking the three dots in the top right of their tweet (if you're using the website or mobile client). Consult Twitter's guide on blocking accounts for more information.

Please be aware that the person will see you have blocked them if they check your Twitter profile. If you are worried this will make the problem worse elsewhere, mute them instead. This will remove their tweets from your timeline and prevent you from seeing any more content from them, but they will still be able to see and comment on all the tweets you make.

If the tweet is from an account which is linked to an osu! player's profile via our website (it will appear underneath their avatar and join date beside a stylised bird icon), please send an email to abuse@ppy.sh containing a copy of the tweet in image form wherever possible, and any other information you can think of.

These clearly show that under the categories of Discord and Twitter related topics, the email should still be used if you can identify and likely prove that the account relates to them. Now about the duration, "1-6 months" is incredibly vague and is not a level of priority I would expect for instances of abuse. Factoring in his task load currently, I could only comprehend a maximum of maybe 2 months, but if I'm really here expecting to wait towards 6 months for something like this to even be read, I seriously believe that the priorities for this are incorrect. I could very well have a biased opinion on this and I am not understanding what he is saying by "I won't help you", if so I'm happy to hear how else to interpret it. Nonetheless, chats (which are tamer) have happened within osu! themselves so there is at least something to go off for peppy for certain.

I could genuinely go on for much longer when it comes to this person, as people that I have contacted about this have continued to share even more experiences that are not publicly known. However, I believe it has been addressed enough and instead I am wishing to now raise public awareness of a somewhat well known player that needs to be exiled from the community, hopefully by peppy himself. If you are in contact or know anyone who is in contact with him, sharing this would be greatly appreciated, and if there's anything you feel that I should include, I am willing to discuss and edit where needed.
