- What makes a good leader and a democracy
- How to deliver a good speech
- When and how to vote
- Significant historical campaigns.

## English

Our focus books for this term are 'Vote for Effie' and 'One Thousand and One Arabian Nights'.

Over the next few weeks, the children will be learning to:

- Plan, draft and edit their writing
- Write journals, diary entries and letters in role
- Include descriptive techniques in short narratives
- Use and apply a wider range of punctuation to their writing
- Include a range of sentence structure in their writing for effect

## Maths

This term, the children will be learning to:

- Recognising the value of each digit in numbers up to 10 million
- Multiplying and dividing numbers by 10, 100 and 1,000, giving answers up to 3 decimal places.
- Using the four operations in the context of fractions and decimals, including addition and subtraction of fractions with different denominators by identifying equivalent fractions with the same denominator.

## PE

Please ensure that your child has their PE kit in school every day. Your child will need the correct P.E kit: white t-shirt, red shorts or black/grey tracksuit bottoms and trainers/plimsolls. This should be brought home every Friday for washing.
