Film Review

View two recently produced **feature-length documentary films**, one about each of your case study countries (streaming from the library or on Netflix/Hulu/iTunes/Roku/YouTube, etc or at the theatre) and write a review comparing the two films. The films you select must be feature-length (not a short or a television episode or series) and must be documentaries, not fictionalized films based on real events. The KCC librarians may be able to assist you in identifying suitable films, and you are welcome to confirm films with the professor if you like.

Please note: your review should be **1-2 pages**- this is based on a newspaper film review (an ancient form of communications used in the 1900s), not on a 1 sentence IMDB or Amazon review. Your review should include summaries and comparisons of the films, along with a discussion of what you learned about comparative politics from watching the two films.
