Coggins

Current negative Coggins is required for all horses, no exceptions. Upload link for pdf is included on the entry form.

Refunds

100% refunds will be given for scratches and cancellations made prior to closing date. Cancellations made after closing will be refunded for class fees but not the office fee. Day of scratches will be refunded at 50%.

Prizes

Ribbons for first through sixth each class

Combined Test (Saturday only)

Open (juniors and adults scored together) classes offered Low (USEA Starter Test A, jumps not to exceed 2'3") and High (USEA Beginner Novice Test A, jumps not to exceed 2'9"). Dressage tests will run in the first part of the day. Jumping will be a mix of stadium and XC type jumps on the derby field after the last dressage test at the end of the day. Knockdowns 4 faults, refusals 4 faults. Faults will be added to dressage scores to determine ranking. Special ribbons to 5th place.

Arenas:

Tests will be held in either a 20x40 meter or a 20x60 meter arena as is designated for that test by USEF, USEA, or WDAA. Intro Tests will be run in the small arena. Entrance will be designated at the venue and clearly marked. Warm up arena will be available.
