Awards will be handed out at the conclusion of each trial or level. Ribbons are awarded for qualifying score, High in Trial, new title ribbons will be awarded. Higher level ribbons will be special ordered.

Venue:

Exhibitors will be crating in their vehicles. Please make sure you bring proper shade to keep your dog comfortable. Please keep dogs crated when not pottying or competing. **Trialing Terriers** reserves the right to remove any individual or dog for any reason from the premises. No refunds will be issued. Please pack shade, food and water for you and your dog. Parking will be outside the property. All trialing areas are perimeter fenced for the property.

Notice to Exhibitors:

- Refunds will be mailed 7 days after the event. Any refunds awarded are at the discretion of the club.
- No refund for cancellations after the closing date.
- No refunds will be made for cancellations after the closing date or entries which are absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by decision of the Trial Committee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. Please double check your NASDA registration number on the NASDA website before entering.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children and/or guests. Any exhibitor whose dogs, children and/or guests repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any entry will be made. Any competitors or dogs that are excused for such behavior will be reported to NASDA.
- All dogs must be on leash on the property at all times except when competing. Please give dogs space.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being in the staging area when it is their turn to run. **Please do not unnecessarily delay a class; get to it as timely and quickly as you can.**
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog. If you see random poop please help us be respectful of the property and pick it up.
- All entries must be accompanied by entry fees to be valid. A declined payment or returned check does not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$30 fee for any returned check or payment. Checks must be made payable to **Stephenie Galvan**.
- **Trialing Terriers** reserves the right to refuse any entry without cause or explanation.
- Trial begins at 8:00 AM.

VOLUNTEERS: A trial cannot run without volunteers. They are essential to the success of a well run trial. If you are interested in volunteering please check the roles you would be interested in helping with.

Volunteer Coordinator – Find, coordinate, and assign duties to volunteers; may require some work prior to the actual trial.

Check-in- Help check in and give directions to competitors. Help them find scores ribbons, etc.

Runner – Help run supplies, scoresheets, bring water or snacks to judges, get food orders. Help find missing competitors for classes. Among any other tasks that may be needed.

Gate Steward – Help to keep track of who has run the class and who may be missing. Let the runners know who we still need for the class. Help keep order and flow of competitors in the cue.

Judges Assistant – Help the judge carry supplies, set the course, or anything else the judge may need assistance with during the class.

Any Volunteer will be given Volunteer Vouchers based on the amount of time they assist. Vouchers can be used for credits on entries, discount on classes or workshops.
