THE TRIUNE GOD

God is uniquely one, yet triune—the Father, the Son, and the Spirit.

Scripture Support: Deuteronomy 6:4; Isaiah 45:5; Matthew 28:19; John 14:16-17, 26; 2 Corinthians 13:14; Ephesians 4:4-6; 1 Peter 1:2; Jude 20-21.

JESUS CHRIST

The Son of God, even God Himself, was incarnated to be a man by the name of Jesus Christ.

Scripture Support: John 1:1, 14; Matthew 1:20-23; Luke 1:35; John 20:28; Romans 9:5; Philippians 2:6-8; Colossians 2:9; Hebrews 1:3, 8; 1 Timothy 3:16.

CHRIST'S CRUCIFIXION

Christ died on the cross for our sins, shedding His blood for our redemption.

Scripture Support: Isaiah 53:5-6; John 1:29; Romans 5:8-9; 1 Corinthians 15:3; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Galatians 3:13; Ephesians 1:7; Colossians 1:20; Hebrews 9:12; 1 Peter 1:18-19; 1 Peter 2:24; 1 Peter 3:18; Revelation 1:5.

CHRIST'S RESURRECTION

Christ resurrected from among the dead on the third day.

Scripture Support: Matthew 28:6; Luke 24:6-7; Acts 2:24, 32; Acts 13:30; Romans 4:24-25; Romans 6:4, 9; Romans 8:11; 1 Corinthians 15:4, 20; 1 Peter 1:3.

CHRIST'S ASCENSION

Christ ascended to the right hand of God to be Lord of all.

Scripture Support: Mark 16:19; Luke 24:51; Acts 1:9-11; Acts 2:33, 36; Ephesians 1:20-22; Philippians 2:9-11; Hebrews 1:3; Hebrews 4:14; Hebrews 8:1; 1 Peter 3:22.

REGENERATION

Whenever any person repents to God and believes in the Lord Jesus Christ, he or she is regenerated, born again, and becomes a living member of the one Body of Christ.

Scripture Support: John 1:12-13; John 3:3, 5-6; Acts 2:38; Acts 20:21; Romans 10:9-10; Romans 12:5; 1 Corinthians 12:13, 27; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Ephesians 1:22-23; Titus 3:5; 1 Peter 1:3, 23.

CHRIST'S RETURN

We look to His imminent return with the kingdom of God, by which He will reign over the earth in the millennium and in eternity.

Scripture Support: Matthew 16:27; Matthew 24:27, 30, 44; Acts 1:11; 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17; 2 Timothy 4:1; Titus 2:13; Hebrews 9:28; Revelation 1:7; Revelation 11:15; Revelation 20:4-6; Revelation 21:1-4; Revelation 22:5, 12, 20.



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
