What Not To Bring List:

- Electronics & cellphones, they will be confiscated and returned at the end of the week
- Extra Money, make sure all money goes into the camp store account for safekeeping
- Medication outside of the original container
- Outside snacks & drinks, we want to ensure the safety of all campers and snacks will be provided in the camp store. Outside food and drinks should not be included in camp mail. If you have specific concerns about this please contact the Camper Advocate.
- Any valuables, PHOC is not responsible for any damage caused to your items
- Blades of any kind including but not limited to pocket knives, swords, and disconnected razor blades (must be connected to razor body)
- Illegal and unprescribed drugs, substances/drugs, drug paraphernalia, and/or alcohol are prohibited
- Substitute drug devices are not allowed, which include but are not limited to electronic cigarettes or vapes
- Lighters or any device of similar function is not allowed
- Weapons of any kind and items resembling weapons are prohibited
- Any material or media that is explicit or inappropriate in nature is prohibited
- Anything that goes against PHOC's value of creating a safe and inviting place for everyone

If any of these items listed above are found, they will be confiscated. We will take appropriate action based on the item either the item will be confiscated completely or returned at the end of the session. If appropriate parents/guardians will be notified and/or appropriate legal action will be taken. Campers found in possession of weapons, drugs, tobacco products, alcohol, or drug paraphernalia will immediately be dismissed from camp and the item(s) will not be returned. PHOC has the right to determine if a certain item is appropriate or inappropriate and make an appropriate decision. By attending camp, all participants are agreeing to bring the appropriate items for camp to the best of their ability. Also, all participants are agreeing not to bring any items on the *What Not to Bring* list. We want to make sure PHOC is a safe environment, so thank you for doing your part in creating this space.
