Code of Conduct

Purpose

This Code of Conduct sets out the standards of professional and ethical behavior expected of all members of the Music Teachers' Association of South Australia (MTASA). It aims to foster a respectful, supportive, and inclusive community committed to excellence in music education.

1. Professionalism and Integrity

- Members shall conduct themselves with honesty, integrity, and respect in all professional interactions.
 - Members are expected to maintain high standards of personal and professional conduct that reflect positively on MTASA and the teaching profession.
 - Members shall comply with all relevant laws, regulations, and policies related to music teaching and education.
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2. Commitment to Students

- Members shall prioritize the wellbeing, safety, and development of their students.
 - Teaching shall be delivered with professionalism, respect, and sensitivity to individual needs.
 - Confidentiality of student information shall be maintained, except where disclosure is required by law or to protect safety.
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3. Ethical Conduct

- Members shall avoid conflicts of interest and disclose any that arise promptly and transparently.

- Members shall not engage in discrimination, harassment, or any form of inappropriate behaviour.
 - Members shall give credit where it is due and respect intellectual property rights.
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4. Inclusivity and Respect

- Members shall foster an inclusive environment within both their teaching practice and the Association.
 - Members shall actively oppose discrimination, bullying, and exclusion in any form within the music teaching community.
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5. Use of Resources

- Members shall use MTASA resources responsibly and for their intended purposes.
 - Members shall respect the property of the Association, its members, and students.
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6. Collaboration and Community

- Members shall support and collaborate constructively with fellow teachers to promote the growth and professionalism of the music teaching community.
 - Members shall communicate respectfully and constructively with colleagues, students, parents, and the wider community.
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7. Commitment to Ongoing Professional Development

- **Full members** are **required** to engage in continuous learning to maintain and enhance their teaching skills and professional knowledge.
 - All members are **encouraged** to pursue ongoing development and to share insights and expertise that enrich the collective knowledge of the MTASA community.

Breaches of this Code of Conduct may result in review and appropriate action by the MTASA Council, including possible suspension or termination of membership.
