



## 2025-2026 Dependent Verification Worksheet

2. A signed copy of your 2023 Federal Tax Return **or** use of the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.
3. A signed copy of your parents' 2023 Federal 1040 Tax Return with Schedules 1, 2 and 3, if applicable, (and only if submitting a paper tax return), **or** use of the FA-DDX by giving consent on the FAFSA.

**Please note:** you may be asked to provide your/your parents' 2023 W2(s) and/or Schedule C, if applicable.
