<u>Financial Aid and FAFSA</u> - All Seniors planning to attend college will need to complete the FAFSA regardless if you qualify for financial aid. Try to apply ASAP after October 1st.

Even if you do not think you will qualify for financial aid, many colleges or universities will require the completion of the FAFSA and use this information to determine scholarship awards.

In order to begin the process both the student and parents need a FAFSA PIN.

Some colleges require an additional financial aid profile. You do not need to complete this unless it is required by the college/university. The CSS profile accesses funding sources different from those associated with the FAFSA.
