We know that you have competing priorities, however balancing your pre-service expectations and your current duties will help prepare you to take on the demands of teaching. If you miss a deadline, you may be jeopardizing your eligibility to start with us at Summer Pre-service and in your classroom. 	Complete certification workshops <action 1,="" 2023="" by="" june="" required=""> New York State requires all teachers to take three (3) certification workshops in order to be eligible to receive their teaching certification: Child Abuse Prevention – complete online School Violence Prevention – complete online Dignity for All Students (DASA) – complete online You must complete the first two (2) workshops by June 1. You will need to submit proof of completion to Relay through your application portal. Information regarding how to take these workshops and proper proof of completion can be found on the Certification Workshop page.</action>
	Register to take Certification Exams and <u>Submit Dates</u> <action asap="" required=""> You must register for the EAS exam and submit your registration dates in the Certification Exam Survey</action>

0	Take EAS exam Ongoing Passing the EAS is one of the testing requirements dictated by New York state in order to qualify for teaching certification. If you need to retake any part of your exams, please sign up for office hours before registering for your retake so we can discuss the best next steps.
	Take CST exam Ongoing You will also need to take the CST (content exam) based on your primary hiring pathway. Please note that if you are hired in your secondary pathway you may need to take a new CST exam that's aligned to your hiring placement.

	Set Up Your TEACH Account Ongoing TEACH is New York State's online portal for teachers to manage their certification credentials. Follow the steps on the TEACH Account page of the info hub to create your account by Monday, July 5 so that you can have your account ready when you apply for certification. It will also allow you to check your fingerprinting status once printed. More guidance will be given from Relay this summer about how to apply for your Transitional-B certificate and Emergency COVID-19 certificate. Please DO NOT apply for these certificates in TEACH at this time. For now, please only create an account.
