Comments:

North Carolina State Board of Examiners of Plumbing, Heating and Fire Sprinkler requires 4,000 hours of on-site, full-time experience in the installation, maintenance, or service in the Heating field prior to taking the licensing exam. However, the State Board will count up to one half (2,000 hours) of the experience requirement through academic or technical training directly related to the field for which the examination is requested, provided the academic or technical training is a minimum of 45 quarter hours or 30 semester hours.

The examination fees for any one group/class is \$100. These fees are subject to change by the State Board of Examiners of Plumbing, Heating and Fire Sprinkler Contractors.

Applicants must also purchase the Board Laws and Rules books for \$15 and obtain a criminal background report from CastleBranch.com for \$30.
