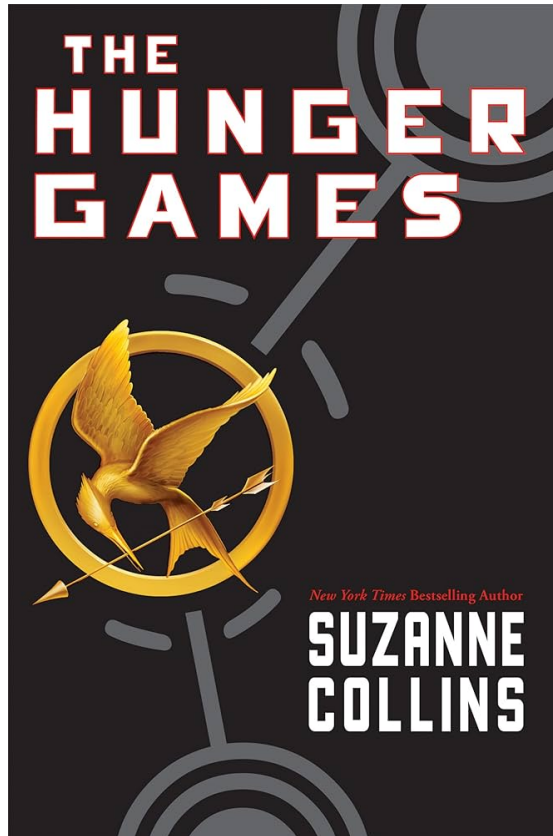




The Hunger Games
