
IJCL DIY Presents:

How to Make an Amphora Goal Poster!

Possible Materials:

- Poster Board
- Construction Paper
- Scrapbooking Paper
- Glue/Tape
- Scissors
- Photographs
- Imagination!



- 1. To make the amphora, draw out the shape of a vase onto construction or scrapbooking paper using a template.
- 2. Cut out the amphora shape and glue it down to the larger poster board.
- 3. Decide how you would like to fill in the amphora. Will you use markers or crayons? Maybe construction paper? If using construction paper, use the template from step one to trace the amphora shape onto a different color piece of paper. Then cut this shape into strips and glue them down as you meet your goals.
- 4. Decide now what your goals will be. Will you want to collect 50 cans in increments of 5 or 100 cans in increments of 20? Once established, make goal markers out of paper to be glued next the amphora.
- 5. Add the title "Fill the Amphora" at the top of the poster, and add any other decorations for flare.
- 6. Hang the completed poster in the classroom to provide inspiration, and make sure to track your progress.
- 7. Fill your amphora with food and love!
