Teacher Cadet students will receive Dual Credit – 1 high school credit on their NFHS transcript and 3 college credit hours on their Winthrop University transcript for EDUC 175. This course includes activities, projects and observations, planning, and teaching lessons. A field experience is an integral part of the course.
