Course goal:	The aim of the course is to introduce students to the basic perspectives of the performance of social work in the environment of organizations and institutions of the Czech Republic that apply social work in their activities.
Abstract:	1. Target groups of social work in the Czech Republic: seniors, the disabled, people at risk of social exclusion, children, ethnic minorities, asylum seekers. 2. This is followed by the selection of the target group that the student will focus on within one organization/institution. Total time subsidy of practice in the organization: 40 hours. Students: - have a knowledge about examples of social work practice in the Czech Republic - have a basic overview of the system of social services - they will be able to present the financing of institutions applying social work and compare it with other examples abroad - evaluate the strengths and weaknesses of the Czech environment in the field of social policy and social work - compare social work interventions across target groups
