2026 VA Loan Limits in Washington State

For veterans with full entitlement, there are typically no loan limits, allowing them to finance the entire home cost. However, for those with partial entitlement, limits may apply, generally aligning with Federal Housing Finance Agency (FHFA) conforming loan limits.

For 2026, the VA loan limits for key counties near JBLM are [4]:

- **Pierce County:** \$1,063,750
- **Thurston County:** \$832,750 (This is the conforming limit for most counties in Washington State) [4] [5]
