

Course Request Frequently Asked Questions

General Questions

Q: What if I am having trouble logging into MyEdBC Student Portal?

A: Please use the MyEdBC link from the RBSS website: <https://royalbay.web.sd62.bc.ca/myed/>

Q: What should I do if I cannot get onto MyEdBC Student Portal?

A: Please refer to the RBSS website <https://royalbay.web.sd62.bc.ca/myed/myed-student-portal/>

If you forgot your password, please click on forgot your password. If you are locked out, please email royalbay@sd62.bc.ca to re-set your account.

Q: Is the course request process first come first serve?

A: No. Once students request their classes (due date for course requests is Feb 9th), we will be using those requests to determine how many of each course we need to offer. It is a lengthy process, and timetables will be completed by the end of August.

Q: What if I post my course requests and realize I made a mistake or want to make a change?

A: You can log back into MyEdBC at any time during the open window to make changes yourself. If the course request window is closed, please email your counsellor of record a detailed message of the changes you are requesting and they will do their best to make changes outside of the course request window.

Q: What if I require further assistance with my course requests in My Ed?

A: Please reach out to your Counsellor of Record for support.

Students going into Grade 10

Q: How many PHE electives am I able to request?

A: You are able to request 1 PHE elective. This excludes the mandatory PHE 10.

Q: If I am in an Academy, am I able to take regular PHE 10 as well?

A: No, the Academy counts as your PHE 10 credit. Please do not request regular PHE 10.

Students going into Grade 11

Q: How many PHE electives am I able to request?

A: You are able to request 2 PHE electives, but this excludes Outdoor Ed and Athletic Leadership.

Students going into Grade 12

Q: How many courses should I request if I plan to graduate early/ take a half day second semester/ do TASK?

A: Everyone should ensure they have 8 courses, and 2 alternates requested.

Q: How many PHE electives am I able to request?

A: You are able to request 2 PHE electives, but this excludes Outdoor Ed and Athletic Leadership.

Q: Does Psychology count as my Socials 12 requirement for graduation?

A: No, Psychology 12 is an elective course and does not meet the requirement for Socials 12. Psychology 12 is not considered an approved academic 12 for post-secondary.
