Collaborator and Accountability:

Independent Learner and Goal-Setting:

Additionally, can you provide an example of when you sought help or guidance to overcome a learning obstacle?

Presenter and Collaboration with Adults:

Public speaking is a valuable skill in entrepreneurship. Describe a situation where you comfortably presented information to a group, and if applicable, collaborated with adults such as mentors. How did you tailor your communication style for different audiences, and how did you incorporate feedback to enhance your presentation skills?

Creator and Responsiveness to Feedback:

As someone who enjoys generating ideas, can you share a specific instance where you responded positively to feedback on one of your creative projects? How did you incorporate suggestions or criticism to improve and refine your ideas?

Reflect on your experience from StartUp Year 1 and answer the following prompts on this [Google Form](#):

Collaborative Growth:

Collaboration is a key aspect of entrepreneurial success. Reflect on your experiences working collaboratively in the first year of the program. How have you fostered a collaborative environment within your team or with external partners? Share specific instances where collaboration has played a significant role in the success of your business or venture. How do you plan to further enhance and leverage collaborative efforts in the second year to achieve greater outcomes?

Leadership Growth:

Reflect on your experiences in the first year of the entrepreneurial program. In what ways have you demonstrated leadership within your business or venture? Share specific examples of how you've motivated and influenced your team, overcome challenges, and evolved as a leader. How do you plan to further develop your leadership skills in the coming year?

Community Engagement and Impact:

Entrepreneurship often involves contributing to and engaging with the community. How have you actively engaged with the community in your first year, and what impact has your business or venture had locally or beyond? In the second year, how do you plan to enhance your community involvement and make a positive difference through your entrepreneurial endeavors?
