<p>APPEAL: Understanding the function of the matrices is important. The automatic qualifying benchmark score during Phase 1 is represented by a total of 6 quality points across the multiple metrics. To account for standard error relative to CogAT scores and variation in student performance, the matrices allow for a range of scores below the maximum qualifying CogAT benchmark score (3) and associates them with fewer quality points. As such, <u>an appeals process is already built into the system.</u> Students who do not meet the qualifying benchmark score on the CogAT are still given consideration if the required quality points are earned in up to four other areas.</p>
