
- Saturday, October 18th from 7:30-9:30pm in the SFMS Cafeteria-students will enter/exit from the BACK of the building





- What it is: Building and maintaining healthy and positive relationships with others.
- Parent Tip: Encourage your child to share, take turns, and express themselves kindly. Model active listening and respectful communication, and teach your child how to resolve conflicts peacefully.

 Activity: Play cooperative games that require teamwork (like building a puzzle together or playing a team sport). Discuss the importance of working together and supporting each other.
