

Guide to Applying and Interviewing for Jobs

Introduction

This is how I have typically approached applying and interviewing for jobs.

Finding Jobs

1. **Use LinkedIn Job Search:**
 - **Example Filters:**
 - **Search Title:** Account Executive
 - **Expertise Level:** Entry Level
 - **Job Type:** Full-time
 - **Remote:** Remote
 - **Industry:** Software Development, Technology, Information, and Internet
2. **Read Job Descriptions (JD):**
 - Scroll to the bottom of the JD to understand what the company does and ensure you are interested.
 - Read through the JD to see if your qualifications align and check the responsibilities to ensure alignment.

Revamping Your Resume

1. **Analyze Multiple JDs:**
 - Scan through several JDs and consider how your background aligns.
2. **Use ChatGPT:**
 - Run your skills, characteristics, and experience through ChatGPT along with multiple JDs you are interested in.
 - Ask ChatGPT to give you examples of how to word your resume.
3. **Use Resume.io:**
 - Ensure your resume format is clean and professional.

Applying for Jobs

1. **Apply Broadly:**
 - Apply for as many jobs as you can that fit your description.
2. **Research the Company:**
 - If very interested in a job, visit the company's LinkedIn page or Apollo.io to search for recruiters, managers, and those in the same position you are applying for.
3. **Contact Key Individuals:**
 - **Recruiters/Managers/Directors:** Request an opportunity to interview.

- **Individuals in the Same Position:** Ask to connect and gain insights into the role.

Preparing for the Interview

1. **Study the Company:**
 - Focus on understanding what the company does and who they serve.
 - Align yourself with the company's mission and objectives.
2. **Use ChatGPT:**
 - Ask ChatGPT for more clarity about what the company does if the concept is difficult to grasp.
 - Perform actual role plays with ChatGPT.
3. **Tailor Your Approach:**
 - Learn how to approach interviewers based on their roles (recruiter, manager, director, peers, CRO, etc.).
 - Connect with people in the position you are going for and ask them questions.
 - Look into courses or communities.
 - Use ChatGPT to simulate interview scenarios.

Role Playing

1. **Importance of Role Playing:**
 - Role playing is crucial for exercising your interview flow.
 - Role play with ChatGPT or friends and family.
 - Provide as much info as you can about the company, what they do, and who you are interviewing with for a great experience.

Final Tips

- **Prepare Thoroughly:** It's better to be over-prepared than to rely on luck.
- **Invest Time:** Be willing to invest hours into your application and interview preparation.
