#### **IV. Old or Ongoing Business – Kristina Kunkle (President)**

- Spirit Wear Distribution: backordered items should be arriving sometime this month. Shipping label update, no exact date of receiving the orders but they should arrive towards the end of January.
- Outdoor Movie Night: rescheduled for April 22, 2022 (Earth Day). We will be watching the movie Lorax and it ties with the Earth Day theme.
- Successful restaurant night at Chipotle on 11/17, we raised \$174.7.
- The PTA typically provides dinner to the HES staff during one of the conference nights in November. Since conferences were remote, we were able to provide a free meal at Kloby's instead, and 43 staff members participated.
- First and fifth grade have scheduled PTA-sponsored in-house field trips.

#### **V. New Business**

- **Administration Report: Ms. Ciarapica**
  - o In-house field trips: there has been a halt on those field trips but will resume when it's safe to proceed.
  - o Contact tracing – there will be a board meeting on 1/12/2022 so everything being shared here is subject to change. Prior to now, contact tracing was done by a QuaranTeam who walk steps back, review seating charts etc. to determine who had been exposed to a person who tested positive for Covid 19. This worked reasonably well in the beginning when we had many cases and then 3 months of no cases. When we returned from winter break, when we receive reports of kids who tested positive and have been in school for the last 48 hours, we inform Health Services and provide educational packets for continued instruction. HES is no longer sending emails, the health department is handling it now. The quarantine period has been shortened from 10 days to 5 days. Staff is no longer considered fully vaccinated unless they have received their booster shots and will be required to quarantine. We have reached a rough patch where many

staff are testing positive including those who are boosted or vaccinated.

- o Klobys – Teachers loved Klobys and expressed heartfelt thanks to the PTA.
- o Beginner concert- an update will be shared shortly. It is scheduled to take place in 2weeks, but HES is planning optimistically to reschedule to the end of February in order to accommodate everyone that would love to attend.

- o Proof of negative result – all results are being sent to Mrs. Rozgonyi (School Nurse). A negative result is no longer required as long as the person has quarantined for 5 days and has shown no fever in 24 hours. A negative result is encouraged but no longer required.
