

ATTENTION ALL WATERFOWL EXHIBITORS:

Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI)

As a safety precaution the Oregon State Fair will be following the recommendation of the Oregon State Veterinarian. Due to Waterfowl being carriers of the HPAI will not be able to attend the fair this year. We hope that next year we can have them back.

ATTENTION ALL RABBIT EXHIBITORS:

Rabbits: Due to Hemorrhagic Disease in Rabbits recent outbreak the Oregon State Fair will be taking the recommendation from The Oregon State Veterinarian. If such an outbreak occurs the rabbit show will be canceled.

Rabbit Hemorrhagic Virus (RHDV) is very easily transmitted by direct contact between rabbits or with contaminated environments or objects, like carcasses or animal products. The virus can also be transmitted by mechanical vectors like insects, scavengers or predators.

There is no treatment for rabbit hemorrhagic disease.

ATTENTION ALL POULTRY EXHIBITORS:

Poultry: Due to the continuing Avian Flu outbreaks the Oregon State Fair will be taking the recommendation from The Oregon State Veterinarian. If such an outbreak occurs the Poultry show will be canceled.

Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) is a serious and deadly disease in domestic poultry. Avian influenza (AI) is an infectious viral disease of birds (especially wild waterfowl such as ducks and geese), often causing no apparent signs of illness. All viruses can sometimes spread to domestic poultry and cause large-scale outbreaks of serious disease.
