- Uptick in robberies, especially targeting the Hispanic community.
- Be aware of your surroundings, and don't go walking at night alone.
- Do not keep valuables in vehicles.
- Robberies have not been solved, although descriptions of suspects are the same in most reports. Undercover officers are investigating.
- Lock garages and secure belongings.
- Several calls to the Red Room Hookah Bar. Vice has been involved and investigating. There is no liquor license at that location, but liquor sales seem to be occurring.
- Call and email District 4 or City Hall to get more officers patrolling the area
- Captain trying to get more traffic enforcement happening on Vine St and Paddock Rd.
- Cameras are helpful to get information about criminals, although may not always be a deterrent. Sharing images with police officers and on social media can help identify suspects.

• The public can contact Detail Coordination of the Police Department to hire off-duty officers to do detail at a specific location.
