Percussion and Color Guard will have additional rehearsals throughout the season as determined by the instructors.

Shared Positions

The Marching Bulldogs use a shadow system to assure that complete field show formations are always present during all performances. This is due to the possibility that a student could move away, get injured, be unable to perform due to grades, drop the class, or not be physically / musically ready to perform at a designated skill level. Students that are unable to attend band camp are automatically designated as shadows. Otherwise, selected freshmen are generally chosen as shadows. The number of shadow positions will vary from section to section. Selected students are paired and both learn a specific drill position. Mr. Stevens, along with the color guard instructor, will select which students perform at any given performance. Shadows will be guaranteed to perform in all parades, and selected field show performances. (Football Games and/or Competitions). During a performance that a shadow is not marching on the field, the student will assist with props and pit. Shadows are expected to be at all rehearsals and performances.

Grading Procedures and Attendance

A student's grade in marching band is based on several factors.

1. Attitude and Effort
2. Attendance and Punctuality
3. Musical Performance
4. Marching Performance

Attendance at every rehearsal and performance is of the utmost importance! Job schedules must be arranged so they do not conflict with scheduled rehearsals and performances. Unexcused absences and tardiness may cause a student to be dismissed from participation or changed from a regular position to a shadow. Also, please try and schedule medical appointments at times that miss scheduled rehearsals. Other Mahomet-Seymour High School activities which conflict with marching band rehearsals will be excused as long as Mr. Stevens is given advance notice. Since band practices continue until 6pm on Tuesday and Thursday, students dismissed from sports practices at 5:30pm should attend the remaining band practice time.

Excused Absences: Death in the family, weddings, illness, school-sponsored activities.
Unexcused Absences: Forgetting or skipping, sleeping in, job conflicts, failing to notify Mr. Stevens in advance for planned excused absences.

Students must be in attendance at all rehearsals and performances.

Failure to request absences in advance will automatically result in an unexcused absence.
