

## **S.Res.1**

### ***In the Senate, U. S.,***

*April, 1995.*

*Resolved*, That there be established a Select Committee on the Death of President Clayton McCall, for the purposes of investigating such event. This committee shall have the authority to investigate all matters, persons, and events leading up to, and those alleged to have caused, the President's death. This Committee shall have all necessary authority to investigate this matter, including issuing subpoenas, taking testimony under oath, and releasing a final committee report. This committee shall have five members, with three members being of the majority party and being appointed by the Senate Majority Leader, and with two members being of the minority party and being appointed by the Senate Minority Leader. This Committee shall expire at the end of this session of Congress, unless this or a similar resolution is renewed or adopted.
