

February Book Report - Pop-Up Book

Genre: Fantasy - Due: Friday, February 28th

Requirements:

1. Cover page (this cover page helps hold together all of the pages with the pop-ups, and allows the book to look finished) with Title, Author of Book, and student name
2. At least 2 pop-up's on each page (can have more if student desires - past 3 can start to get a little messy) Pop-up's can be drawn by student, or printed out, but should have color
3. 1 page for each of the story Elements - listed below
4. A description on each page (1-2 sentences on each page describing the story element)

6 Story Elements:

- Plot (A main event that happens in the beginning, middle, and end of the story - 1 sentence for each, resulting in 3 sentences on this page)
- Setting (Where the story takes place/year or time of year if mentioned)
- Characters (main character and at least 2 others)
- Problem (What goes wrong in the story)
- Solution (How the problem is solved; resolution)
- Theme (Moral or lesson that the character learned. Example: It is important to work together; Never give up; Be kind to everyone)

In total: Cover Page, 6 Pages in your book, with 2 colored pop-up's on each page, and 1 sentence description on each page
