# Scheduling an Appointment

During the school day, our staff is busy making sure all of our children are getting a world-class education. If you would like to meet with a staff member, please contact us to schedule an appointment. ## Snacks and Treats in the Cafeteria

I want to share a quick reminder about snacks and treats at school. Families can place limits on student lunch accounts to help manage how many snacks students can purchase. Without a limit, it's not unusual for a child to buy several treats in one day—which often means skipping their meal and getting a big sugar rush instead.

Our family handbook also encourages sending a healthier option for birthday celebrations rather than sugary treats. We know this is a culture shift, and we haven't enforced it strictly, but we'd love your support in moving toward healthier choices. Simple options like popcorn or popsicles can make celebrations fun without adding quite so much sugar.

This helps keep our students healthier and makes it easier for our teachers to support focused, happy learners throughout the day.

#### What is the procedure for volunteering?

To volunteer, parents must register per the instructions below:

#### **New Volunteers**

Anyone who plans to volunteer for the 2025-26 school year must register using the <u>WCPSS</u> <u>volunteer system</u>. Click "Create New Account" and complete the required fields. This registration can be completed anywhere. You do not have to be on a WCPSS campus.

#### **Returning Volunteers**

If you were an approved volunteer for the 2024-25 school year, you simply have to renew your volunteer registration. This must be done by October 1, 2025. To do so, visit your <a href="MyVolunteer">MyVolunteer</a> account and follow the steps for volunteer renewal. If this is not done by the October 1 deadline, you must follow the steps above to register as a new volunteer.


