- i. Opening Prayer (Fr. Matt)
- ii. Review of Minutes from Last Meeting (March 19th)
 - a. Mike Long made the motion to approve, Pam Bray 2nd, all in favor to approve.
- iii. New Business:
 - a. E-Giving Update for Holy Trinity (Fr. Matt)
 - a. Holy Spirit has been using Our Sunday Visitor the last 14 years, they do not have to switch to this Vanco E-giving platform, this is just for Holy Trinity. Can make a donation to the general fund, or the youth Ministry Program. This is similar to VENMO but, not quite, and can be used for dinners and basket raffles in the future.
 - b. This launched last month, Father Matt hosted an information session and no one showed up. Two people are giving on line, Father Matt is one of them.
 - c. He can make more of these flyers and pass them out if needed
 - d. there is no monthly maintenance fee and no pressure to get a number of users.
 - e. Not a sense of frustration yet, will take time.
 - b. Email newsletter from Pastor vs. Hallow subscription (Fr. Matt)
 - a. wanted ways to increase communication

 - c. Father Matt met with a Rep with Hallow, it's \$5k a year, drops to \$4k a year if you commit to two years. It's expensive, Father Matt doesn't feel it's worth it to go beg to Helpers Store at this point.
 - d. With Hallow, you can send notes from a Priest.
 - e. Ann suggested Instagram and Facebook to engage the younger generation as well
