DIANA L. HAHN MEMORIAL EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

For Graduating Students of North & Oostburg High Schools Majoring in Education 2024 - 2025

The Diana L. Hahn Memorial Education Scholarship is available to graduating seniors of Sheboygan North and Oostburg High Schools who wish to pursue a degree in education. This scholarship was created in the Fall of 2018 by the Hahn family to honor the memory of their mother/grandmother, Diana L. Hahn.

Diana started her teaching education at her local community college, then pursued her Bachelor's Degree from UW-Eau Claire and her Master's Degree from UW-Oshkosh. She started her teaching career in the Flambeau School District and then retired from the Oostburg School District after 36 years of teaching serving primarily as a 1st grade teacher and Reading Specialist.

She enjoyed traveling with her friends and family, playing various games, and watching both professional sports and her grandchildren play sports. She was always an active member of her church and community. After retirement, her volunteerism went into overdrive. She was active with Thrivent Financial, Senior Center, local food pantry, SCARTA, Gus Macker, just to name a few. She was an incredible person who positively affected the lives of her students, family, and others around her. She always thought of the needs of others and did everything she could to help them.

Two scholarships will be awarded, one at North High and one at Oostburg High, and will be \$500 paid in two \$250 installments; the first upon proof of enrollment in an accredited college or university and the second upon completion of the first semester with proof of a 3.0 or higher grade point average and proof of second-semester enrollment.

Criteria:

- 1. Candidates must be a full-time member of the graduating class of North or Oostburg High Schools
- 2. Must have a high school GPA of 3.0 or higher
- 3. Must attend an accredited college or university on a full-time basis, intend to pursue a career in education, and earn a 3.0 GPA during the first semester to be eligible for the second payment
- 4. Applications will be evaluated based on: the content of the application, high school academic performance, personal characteristics, involvement in high school and community activities, and content of Diana L. Hahn Memorial Education Scholarship essay, two Diana L. Hahn Memorial Education Scholarship recommendation FORMS (one to be completed by a supervisor of volunteer work), and financial need.

Application Procedure:

- 1) Complete the Diana L. Hahn Memorial Education Scholarship **Application**
- 2) Compose/Answer Diana L. Hahn Memorial Education Scholarship essay questions: What has inspired you to become a teacher? In what ways have you already and will you continue to give back to your community in the future? (Limited to ONE page)
- 3) Obtain TWO **Recommendation Forms...No Letters of Recommendation accepted**. (one to be completed by a supervisor of volunteer work)
- 4) Return ALL scholarship materials and a copy of your **Transcript** to North High Student Services by April 1st, 2025.
