What can't you create? :)

- **New Teacher Onboarding**
 - How to use the online gradebook
 - How to submit attendance

- **District/School Wide Compliance-** You can upload already created videos and have a challenge or a link to a google form for teachers to complete.

- **PLC or Data Teams-** You can create videos or create a screen recording using voice and slides for your teachers to watch together or independently and then have them work on a task together.

- Create content for your PLC teams to review in a course and then submit artifacts produced in meetings.
- **Teachers on a Professional Development (or Remediation) Plan-** You may have teachers on a remediation plan after unsatisfactory observations. You could create or find videos to use and assign them to specific teachers.
 - Create or use videos to further develop a teacher's skills in arrears such as
 - Lesson planning
 - Classroom management
 - Student discipline
 - Communicating with parents
- **District/School Wide Digital Programs and/or Tools-** You could enlist teacher experts at your school to create instructional videos for programs you teachers have access to and create a challenge or a multiple choice question to go along with it. If you want to have more than one question, you can link a Google form to your course and have teachers complete that. You could make the multiple choice question be, "Have you completed the form linked in the course content?" Many programs may also have Google classroom integration capabilities so you could create videos showing how that works as well.
