

KODIAK 2022 - HOW TO ROLLOVER FROM 2020

**THIS DOCUMENT REFERS TO 2020 ROLLOVERS MADE BY JULY 1, 2020
DUE TO THE COVID PANDEMIC**

How do I get my rollover from 2020?

You will not be automatically registered for any race. All rollover entries must be registered by May 1, 2022 or your rollover credits will be expired. Runners with rollover credit will NOT be able to register for any event that becomes sold out.

Step-by-step instructions:

- 1. Complete this form no later than May 1, 2022
- 2. Within 72 hours your credits will be added to your account in Ultrasignup if you want to register for the 100M, 100K, or 50K. Credits are linked to the email address you used when you originally rolled over.
- 3. To use your rollover credit to sign-up for the Half Marathon or 10K, complete the form and we will contact you via email with a coupon code to use on Runsignup.com.
- 4. Register for your race. You will not be automatically registered. You have until May 1 to complete your registration on either Ultrasignup (100M, 100K, 50K) or Runsignup (Half, 10K).
- 5. NOTE YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE A CONFIRMATION EMAIL FROM US WHEN THE CREDITS ARE APPLIED FOR THE 100M, 100K, or 50K. YOU MUST CHECK BACK IN ULTRASIGNUP AND COMPLETE YOUR REGISTRATION BY MAY 1.

After registering for the 2022 event, all current policies in place will apply to your registration. Note: Rollover registrations cannot be rolled over further (i.e. to any events after 2022).

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can I change distances?

If you wish to 'upgrade' your distance, you can do that. Sign-up early for the best pricing and to quarantee your spot. You must register by May 1 to use your credit.

If you were registered for the:

- 50K: You can use your credits toward any distance. If you 'upgrade' your distance, you will just pay the difference.
- 50M: You can upgrade to the 100K for <u>no extra charge</u> or you can use your credits toward any other distance. If you 'upgrade' to the 100M, you will just pay the difference.

• 100M: You can use your credits toward any distance. No remaining credits can be rolled over, the Ultrasignup system is not setup to process that.

Is there somewhere I can check to see if I qualify for a rollover from 2020?

If you followed our process back in 2020 and elected to rollover, you will find your name and race distance here.

<u>Is there somewhere I can check to see what email address my race credits are linked to?</u>

If you followed our process last year and elected to rollover, you will need to log-in to Ultrasignup and/or use the same email address you did when you originally registered to use your credit. You can find which email address you used here.

Can I receive a refund instead of rolling over to 2022 event?

The refund period is now closed. If you don't use your existing credit for the 2022 event, you will lose it.
